These parts of you are unique !**



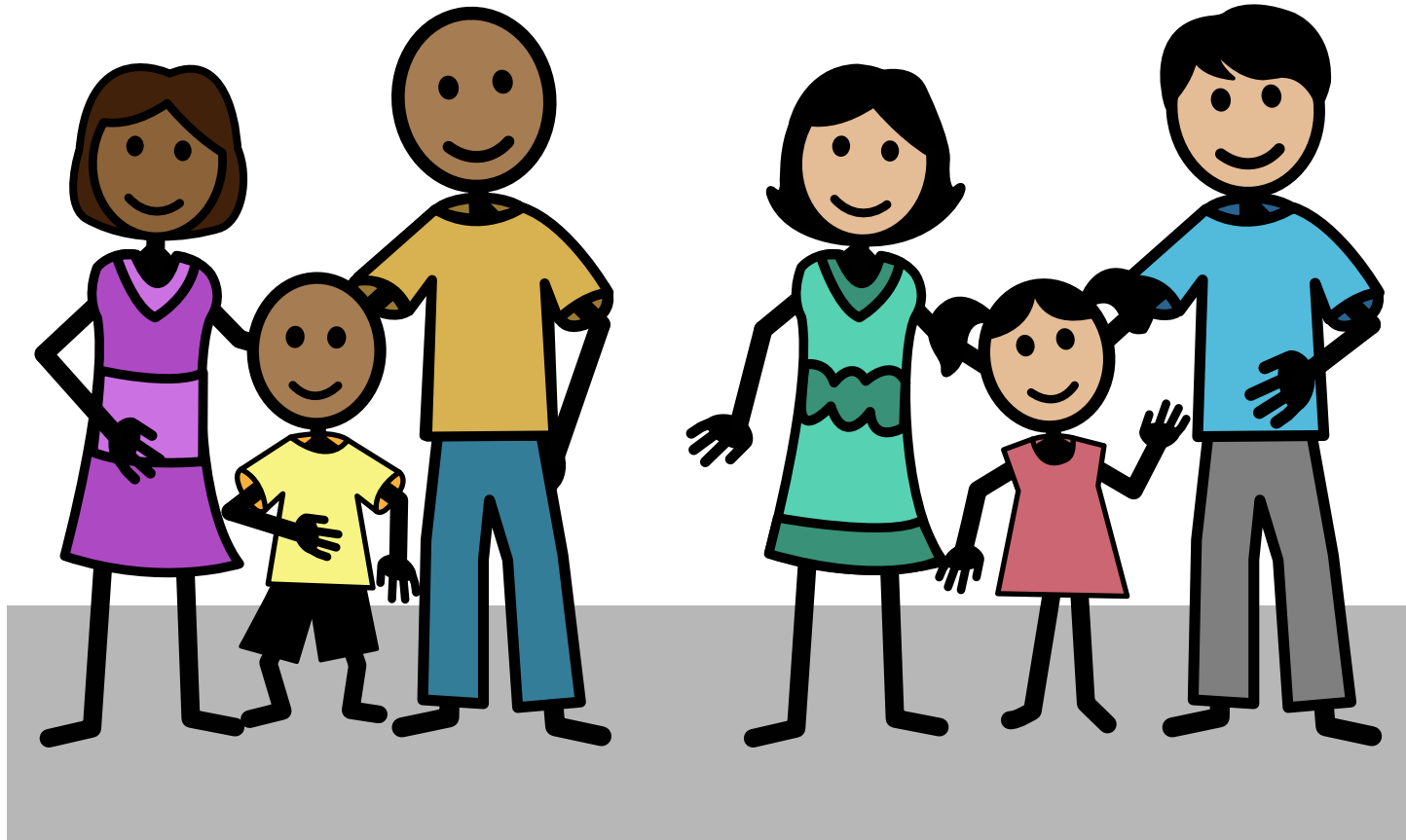
**Genes help make you unique.

They give information to your body.**



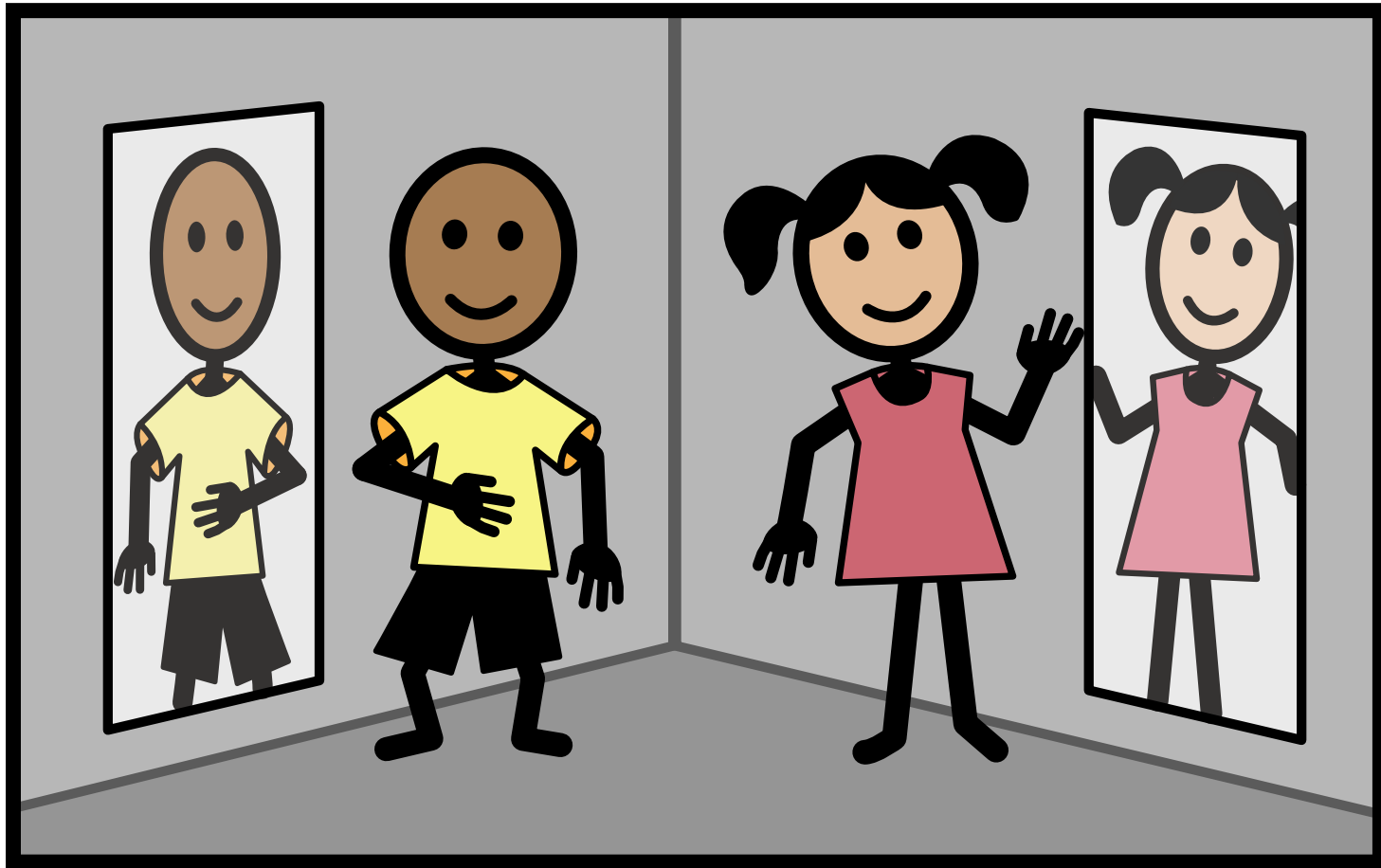
Genes can give your hair color.

Genes help describe how you look.



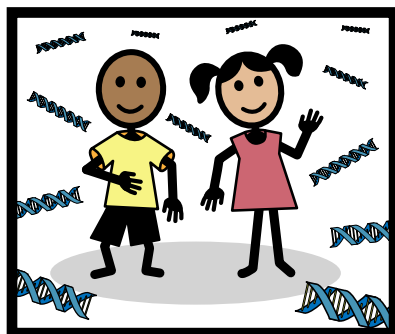
**Parents share genes with you.
That is why your family looks alike.**



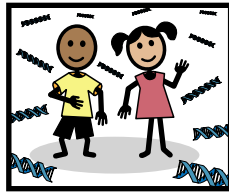
