Life Cycle of a Person

This story introduces the life cycle of humans. We refer to the person as the male, "he", but this could also be referring to the female, "she."



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The **life cycle** of a person begins as a baby and moves to old age. Each step of this cycle brings changes to the person. Each stage of this development has a name for that time of life. We will explore the life cycle of a person and the names for these steps in the life cycle.

Infant

lives inside of the mother for nine months before he is born. When a baby is born, he needs the mother to take care of him. The mother, or another caring person, must feed

Infant is another name for a baby. A baby



the baby. The baby will learn to cry when he is hungry. The baby cannot walk, so a big person must carry him. A baby is always learning. It is good to talk to the baby, even if the baby can't talk.

Toddler

A **toddler** is a very young child. He is learning to walk. When he walks, he may move back and forth and fall down. This is called a toddle walk. A toddler is learning to talk. The toddler may say words when he wants a drink or a ball to play with. The toddler still needs someone to help him most of the time.

Child

A child is a young person.

A child can do many more things for himself. A child can feed himself. A child can walk and run. A child



has learned to talk so that he can tell others about what he wants. When a child is about six years old, he will go to school. This is a time to begin to learn to read and write.

Teenager

A **teenager** is a person who is 13 to 19 years old. The word "teen" is in his age. A teenager

pick his own clothes
and dress himself. A

many friends. A teenager is now getting ready to graduate from school.

A young adult is thinking about what he wants to do with his life. Where does he want to live? What kind of job does he

getting married. All of these changes take responsibility. The young adult must plan on how he will make money and spend money.

Adult

An adult is a grown up person. Being an

adult means working every day at a job. Being an adult means buying groceries at the store. It means cooking meals. Some adults will have a family.

These adults must take care of the babies and young children.



Older Age

Everyone will get older. But many older people do not like to be called old. As a person gets older, the body sometimes feels more tired. It is harder to do things without help. Older age people will retire from their jobs. Some older people are grandmothers and grandfathers.





The life cycle takes us through many changes. Our body will grow in each step of the life cycle. We have different responsibilities at each step of the life cycle. But the life cycle is a normal part of life. We all must go through the cycle of life.






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

































































Glossary
