

Martin Luther King, Jr. was <u>wedded</u> to Coretta Scott in 1953. They later had four children.

Martin Luther King, Jr. was a leader who promoted the changing of unfair laws.




What does promoted mean?



Alabama had <u>segregation</u> laws, which kept white people separate from black people in places like schools and restaurants.

In 1964, Dr. King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize for his work.

After a black woman was arrested for not giving up her bus seat to a white person, Dr. King led a bus boycott, asking blacks to not ride the bus.



The police used <u>force</u> against Dr. King and his followers, so some in his group were badly hurt.
