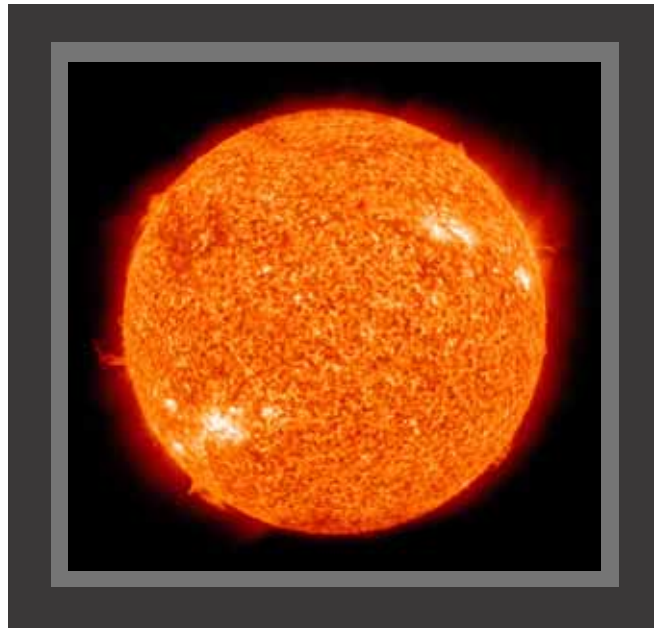

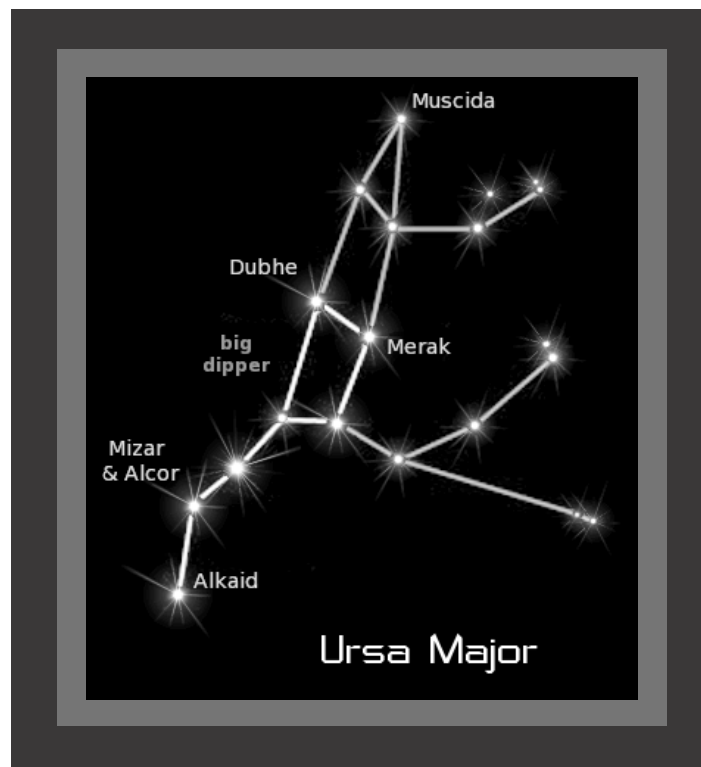

There are millions of stars in the sky. Did you know the Sun is a star? It is the closest star to the Earth. The stars are in the sky in the day and night. During the day, the Sun makes the sky so bright that we cannot see the other stars. At night when the sky is dark, the light of the stars can be seen.

Constellations are pictures made up of bright stars which appear close to each other in the sky. The Big Dipper is a group of stars that looks like a ladle. There are seven stars in the Big Dipper. The flag of the state of Alaska has the Big Dipper on it.
